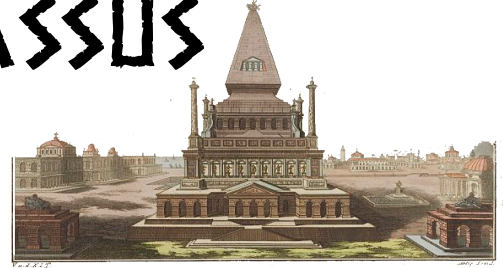




THE MAUSOLEUM AT HALICARNASSUS
