The game is rigged. (Shocking, I know!) The small gray numbers in the lower right corner of each green apple card indicate the order in which they should be played.
Each player's set of red cards all have the same double letters in the titles: "nn," "oo," "ss," or "ee."
The cheat sheet below shows who should win each hand:

| Green Card (GC) | Red Card (Player) |
| :---: | :---: |
| Flamboyant | nn |
| Elegant | ee |
| Delicious | ss |
| Crunchy | nn |
| Hypsiloid | ee |
| Good | ss |
| Banal | $\mathbf{o o}$ |
| Awesome | nn |

(It actually doesn't matter what order you play the green cards if you can remember which player should win each hand. This just makes it easy for video gamers to remember the winning sequence: NES-NES-ON.)

Once all these pairs are matched, the "nn" player wins. Order the red cards by their green card partners, then use one of each doubled letter to spell the answer: NONSENSE
