

THE NUT ROOM.

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
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The name of each nut Caesar shifts (or rot ciphers) to a new word that can be described by one or more of the underlined squirrel words (The number of nuts describes how many squirrels use the new word). The error code is how many letters forward each word is shifted. Following the instruction given by the first letters of all of the squirrel's names (ERROR CODE ALPHANUM[eric]), reading downward spells out the answer 'Limited Time Offers.'


Example:

If a "Pecan" nut happens to rot, it will turn into a "Tiger". This incident has an error code of 4.


2 = RGECP4 = TIGER1 = OFDBO3 = SHFDQ




To use the nut cracker, cut out the bar on the right-hand side of the page, and line up the arrow on the bar on the bottom of the page with an error code. Convert the letters on the top bar corresponding to the original nut to the letters on the bottom bar corresponding to the rotten nut.
