


## ELLIS & ELEVATORS NAKATOMI PLAZA - FLOOR 30


#### **CIRCUIT CIRCUS**

How should John reach the roof?



Each bolded set of words is a clue for the left-hand blanks (i.e. Social Site = Facebook.) Similarly, each set of left-hand blanks is a clue for the right-hand blanks (i.e. Chess Call = Check). The right-hand blanks give the clue "ORDER GROUPS, CHECK THIRD LETTER." Ordering the groups (bodyguards, pensioners, etc.) alphabetically, and then taking the third letter gives the final answer of DETONATORS.
