

Chorophobia - Fear of dancing

Answer:

This is a variation of a basic chess logic puzzle. Each lyric gives the movement of a chess piece, and the solver needs to figure out the steps taken. The notes give the number of squares moved on each line. Each dancer makes an identical movement, in a different orientation. The steps are marked below.

The completed movements spell: LETTERS / RIGHT OF / DANELLE / BZXOPGG. The letters to the right of BZXOPGG (keeping track of Danelle's orientation) spell RAPIDLY

- ↑ Stroll back like you're goin' away Rook Back 2
- ↑ Then take a slide in a diagonal way
- Bishop Back-right 2
 March forward at a moderate pace
 Rook Forward 3
 - Diag again and to your partner you face

 Bishop Forward-right 2 and rotate to center
- Get on a horse and ride like a knight
- Knight Right 2 and Up 1
 Diag once more like the string of a kite
 Bishop Forward-right 3
 Spin to your partner once last time
- Rotate to center

 Stride forward & be done with this rhyme

 Rook Foward 3
