

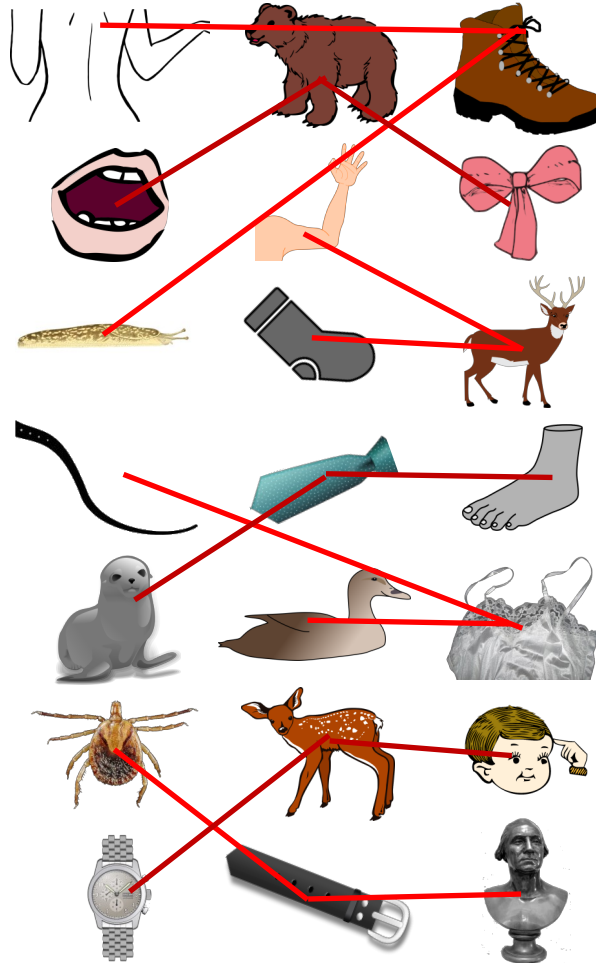


Different Meanings

Wave a flag when you've figured out what these body parts, animals, and clothing have in common!

Each color refers to an item in the picture according to its group. So "help me" is red, so it refers to a body part. The only body part that matches is "To Back" which is to help or support. You're often changing the pictures which are nouns into their verb form, e.g. "to mouth", meaning to silently speak).

If you apply semaphore to the order of the items from each line, they spell out what these have in common, they are all HOMONYMS.



"Will you help me toss out this guy that punched me?"

BACK-BOOT-SLUG (H)

"I was following him, then I lost him when he went into an alley."

TAIL-SLIP-DUCK (O)

"Let's close the deal on our merger, then I'll be happy to pay the bill."

SEAL-TIE-FOOT (M)

"I grabbed my gun after he countered my punch."

ARM-BUCK-SOCK (O)

"I silently cursed at having to grovel."

MOUTH-BEAR-BOW (N)

"Another bucket list item complete: I sang a song; it wasn't well received."

TICK-BELT-BUST (Y)

"I saw the people's love for their leader."
