Rooms

- Tunnel RORE
- "Bye!", in Bologna CIAO
- VHS successors DVDS
- Austen title heroine EMMA
- URL beginning HTTP
- Apple's desktop M A
- __-Aid (drink mix) KOOL
- Evaluate R ATE
