## Bridge \& ...

This is a hashiwokakero ("hashi" or "bridges") puzzle. Connect islands (circles) with bridges. An island's number shows the number of bridges that connect it. Bridges go north-south or east-west, no other angles. Bridges can't cross. A pair of islands might be connected by one bridge or two bridges, but no more. In this puzzle, loops are not permitted. Find the word on the route from $\&$ to $\&$.

Final answer is the route-word's partner.


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
