

Batteries Not Included

The power requirements for this product are very complicated: inside the battery compartment there are many slots, and batteries must be inserted into the correct slots, with the correct orientation, according to the following rules:

- Every battery has a positive (+) and a negative (-) terminal
- Batteries must be inserted into the slots shown below, so that:
 - The number of + terminals in each row/column equals the total printed at the right/above
 - The number of terminals in each row/column equals the total printed at the left/below
- Not all slots need to be filled! Only insert enough batteries to provide the exact power stated for each row/column
- Batteries may be placed in adjacent cells, but positive terminals cannot be placed next to other positive terminals, and negative terminals cannot be next to other negative terminals (diagonals are ok)

Ouzild Some Assembly May Be Required

This product was delivered in pieces that need putting together: fortunately, each piece has labelled connectors on the sides. The only instructions provided are as follows:

Step 1: Cut out the square pieces (\times 16)

Step 2: Assemble into a 4×4 grid

IMPORTANT!!! Rotate and position the pieces as required to ensure touching connectors **fit together from both directions**. Sometimes it may seem that there are several possible connectors that can be joined together, but there is only one correct way that the complete product can be assembled.


