## ARTIMIS SOLUTION

## Answer: PATROL

Each set of four clues correspond to four eight-letter words circling each target from the outside ring going in, as illustrated by the first answer, given as AGNOSTIC.

When a set of words is written into a target, a nearly complete nine-letter word is revealed across it. The bull's-eye contains the missing middle letter; first, the " $P$ " in ACRO_OLIS, then the "A" in PAGE_NTRY, and so on. Once all six targets are complete, the six "bull's-eye" letters spell out the answer, PATROL.

The completed nonogram shows a lightning bolt (appropriate for Zeus) and seemingly random squares filled in. When read backwards row by row, the letters in the lightning bolt reveal a message: IF YOU WISH TO LEARN THE POWER OF ZEUS KING OF THE GODS TRANSLATE THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE PUZZLE TO MORSE CODE. (Morse code's association with the telegraph, the first mode of communication to use electricity, is just a nice easter egg.)

Interpreting two-wide boxes as a dash and one-wide boxes as a dot, the six lines of morse code spell out --/../--. / ..../-/-.--, or MIGHTY, the puzzle answer.

As fail safes, the Morse code boxes read "HI THIS IS THE MORSE CODE STOP," and the blank spaces spell "IGNORE THE BLANK SPACES THE REST WILL BE TOTAL GIBBERISH NOW," followed by total gibberish.
