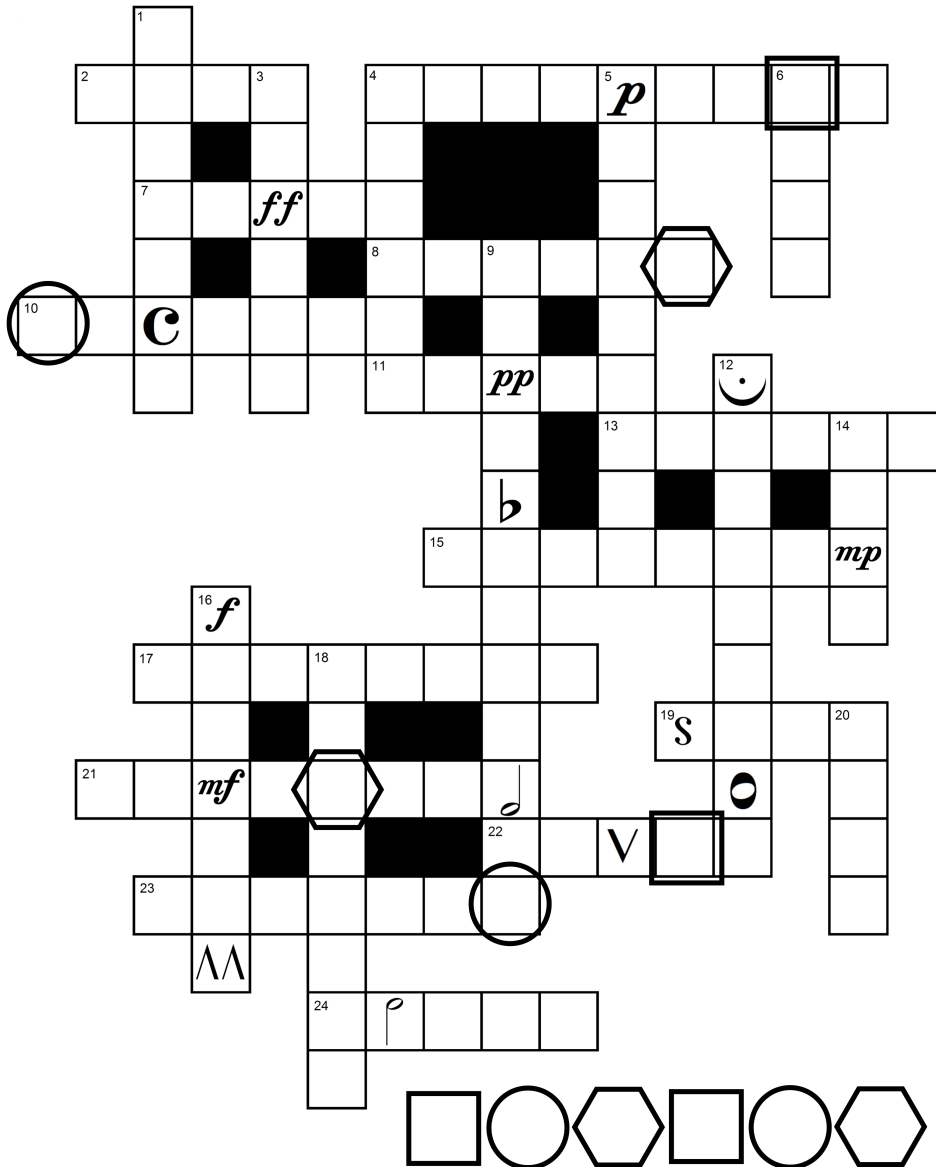


Music Crossword
