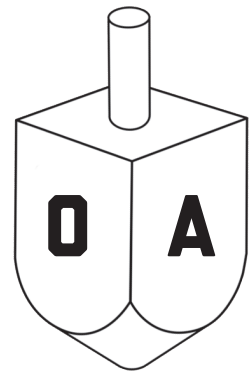
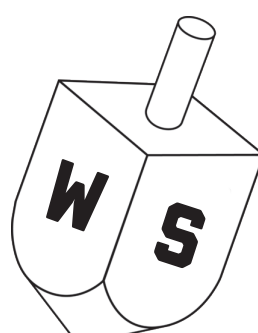
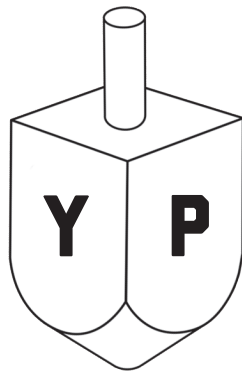
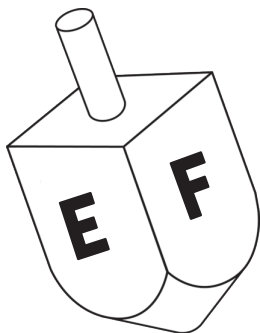
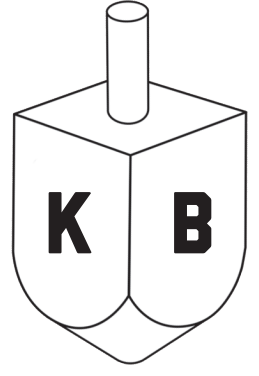
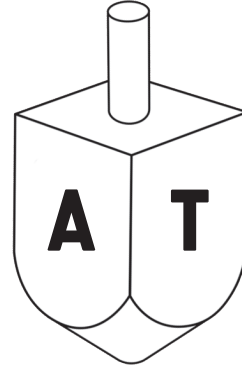
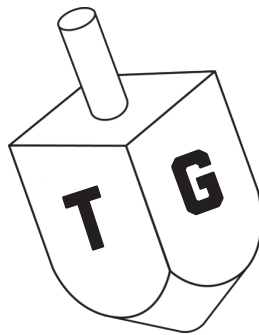
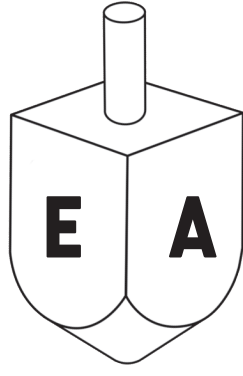
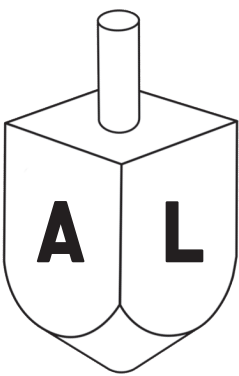
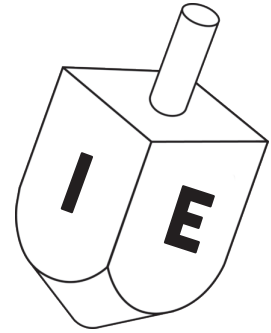
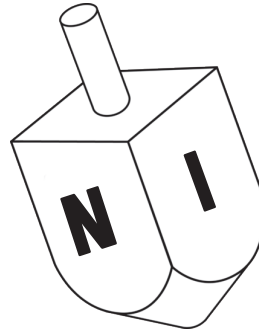
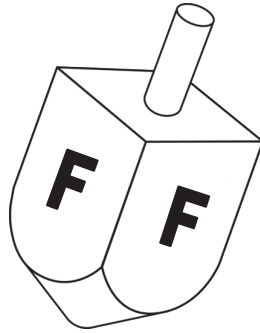
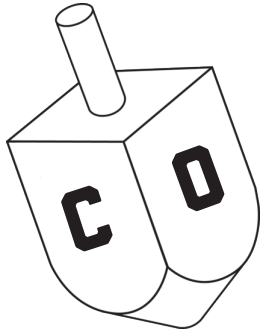




Spin the Dreidels by Sandor W. (Chicago)
