## Location Puzzle Solution

1. Solve the word search. There are 40 words, all having at least 4 letters. Most relate to pirates. There are a couple words not on the list; circling them will not affect the puzzle. (Full word list: ALONE, ASHORE, BELT, CANAL, CANNON, CANOE, CAPTAIN, CHEST, CLIMB, CROOK, CURSE, GRASP, HORN, IRON, JOHNNYDEPP, LAMP, LAST, NEED, ONCE, OPENSEAS, PARROT, PEGLEG, PIRATE, PLANK, PLOT, PLUNDER, PROP, RACE, RAGE, REDBEARD, ROPE, SAGA, SALT, SCURVY, STEAL, TALE, TIKI, TIRE, TREASURE, VOYAGE)
2. Two letters are left in the word search: J and R.
3. The first letter of each line of the poem reads "USE MAP TWO"
4. The word search is the exact same size as the map. If you overlay the word search on map two, the letters "JR" are directly over the Jolly Roger, a pirate bar on SE $12^{\text {th }}$ and Madison.
