

Make It Snow!

Page 1 of 3 Puzzle by DeeAnn Sole (Portland)

- Match dates to events on page 2, and trivia on page 3. All holidays and events happen this winter (2014 - 2015).
 NOTE: Precise, straight lines will give a better result!
- 2. Cut out the square, through the centers of all the connected dots.
- 3. Fold the square piece of paper into a triangle along the diagonal, making sure both "A"s end up visible on the same side of the fold, and "B"s and "C"s are on the other side.
- 4. Fold the big triangle in half, so that the "A"s lie flat against each other, to make a right triangle with the "B"s and "C"s visible on the outsides.
- 5. Fold that smaller triangle in half again so that the "B"s lie flat against each other. The only visible letters should be the "C"s.
- 6. Fold the current triangle's short side to its long side so the "C"s lie flat against each other. No letters should now be visible, and the shape should look like an ice cream cone with a shark fin sticking up out of the top.
- 7. Use scissors to CUT OFF the "shark fin" portion along the top, horizontal edge of the "ice cream cone" shape.
- 8. Hold the "ice cream cone" with fold toward the right and the tip down. The lines you drew in step 1 should separate the shape into several regions, some of which contain parts of the Xmas trees or ornaments.
- 9. Cut out the regions which do not contain parts of trees or ornaments on the side facing you. Ignore the other side. Cut out lines that run along the edges, but never cut ACROSS a shape.
- 10. Unfold the paper until it lies completely flat.
- 11. Line up your paper with page 3; some cutouts will help align the page, while others will select some of the words you wrote.
- 12. The first letters of the selected words spell out the name of someone associated with a certain winter holiday. Who is it?
