Each edge has a word that corresponds to either the first or second of a puzzle answer:
SHUFFLE: DANCE, RIFFLE, RANDOMIZE, ARRANGE
AWAY: GONE, FAR, ELSEWHERE, ABSENT
LITTLE: SMALL, TINY, MINIATURE, YOUNG
ALICE LIDDELL: NIECE OF LEWIS, GIRL, KID, CHILD
BEAUTIFUL: HANDSOME, COMELY, ATTRACTIVE, PRETTY
SOUP: BISQUE, MINESTRONE, CONSOMME, BROTH
MAKES: FABRICATES, PRODUCES, CREATES, GENERATES
NOTES: CDEFGABC, DO RE MI FA SO, LOGS, RECORDS
Arranging the squares so each edge forms a pair corresponding to one of SHUFFLE/AWAY, LITTLE/ALICE LIDDELL, MAKES/NOTES, BEAUTIFUL/SOUP produces a Connect-the-Dots of a grinning cat - the CHESHIRE CAT
