

Puzzle by Justin W. Allison Park PA



Note that the first letters of the ladies' names spell "size five", and that each quote has exactly one five-letter word. You can make eight "matches" where the pair's five letter words share four letters and only one differs. Note the unique letter held by the lady and the guy. Ladies (first!) spell "PLENTY OF" and guys spell "IN THE SEA". The final match is to add "FISH" in between.
