



# Mawidge...

Match one picture from the “outer ring” group with the appropriate picture from the “shaded ring” group, and enter them into their proper blanks. Then, starting on the letter that falls inside the box, move either **Right** (forward in the alphabet) or **Left** (backward in the alphabet) the number of letters indicated by the number ring. Look to what’s special about each pair of words to tell you which way to go. Put the resulting letters in the correct order in the innermost circle to find out what the Clergyman is babbling about.

## Outer ring

If the original word had an “r” that changed to a “w,” go right around the circle.  
 If the original word had an “l” that changed to a “w,” go left around the circle
